

3. Wrap the charge cable counter-clockwise around the Wall Connector and insert the charge handle into the holster.



CHECKOUT PROCEDURE

Failure to comply with the check-out procedures and expectations can result in added cleaning fees. At the conclusion of your stay please complete the following items:

- Report any accidental or intentional/reckless damages.

OTHER DETAILS

TOWELS

Please do not use solid-colored towels for the hot tub. Hot tub towels are provided.

GRILL

Electric grill is provided for your use. Please ensure the grill is turned off and unplugged when not in use to prevent electrical hazards and ensure safety.

FIRE EXTINGUISHER

The fire extinguisher can be found under the kitchen sik.

FIRST AID KIT


The kit is conveniently located under the kitchen sink.

PET ACCOUTREMENTS

Poop bags, leash, dog bowls/feeding mat, and pet first aid kit is located in the upper cabinet at the front entry mudroom.

HOT TUB INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. With TWO people, gently flip & glide back the cover. Do not force or jam cover lift system.
- 2. Cycle Through Modes and lighting options. Enjoy.
- 3. When exiting the hot tub, please turn off all jets, and lights, and return the temperature to 100 degrees.
- 4. Cover the hot tub.





HOT TUB RULES

- The tub is to be used responsibly and is not to be used as a substitute wading pool by children. Allowing children to jump or dive into the water is not permitted under any circumstances. Children must not use the spa unsupervised at any time. No infants or toddlers in the spa.
- Please shower before using the tub to remove make-up, sunscreen, insect repellent or any other oil-based products.
- Only clean swimwear may be worn in the tub as the chemicals in the water will remove the colored dyes found in ordinary clothing, causing them to leach into the water and turn it cloudy.
- Prevent accidental drowning. Leave the hot tub cover on when the spa is unsupervised and/or not being used.
- Prevent Hyperthermia. Understand that alcohol and other medications greatly increase the chance of hyperthermia the opposite of hypothermia. This occurs when the internal body temperature reaches several degrees above the normal temperature of 98.6 degrees.
- NO GLASS or food in or around the spa.
- Capacity is defined for 6 people.
- Do not attempt to access any of the controls other than the temperature and jet controls.
- Do not use a hot tub if you are taking any medication that makes you drowsy or affects your circulation; if necessary, check with your doctor. Pregnant women and the elderly should also consult their doctor before using a hot tub.
- Do not use the hot tub if you are under the influence of alcohol or drugs as your judgment will be impaired and you could become unconscious and drown.
- No smoking is permitted in or around the tub.
- People with cuts or external infections should not use the tub.
- Shoulder length hair or longer should be restrained as it can get caught in the drainpipes and cause harm or drowning.
